

Block of the Month for October

Here is block number eight of our block of the month quilt. This is a very easy quilt block. There are only two shapes this time - triangles and squares. Each letter on the diagram represents a fabric. If you have questions please call me at 408-264-7121.

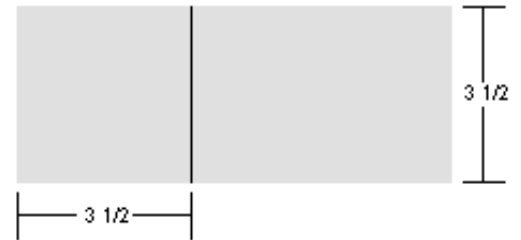

(Note the colors used in the block above are the ones that I am using for my block of the month Quilt).

Cutting:

1. Cut four 3 1/2" by 3 1/2" squares out of fabric **A**.
2. Cut four 3 1/2" by 3 1/2" squares out of fabric **B**.
3. Cut one 6 7/8" by 6 7/8" Square out of fabric **C** and cut diagonally once. You will have two fabric **C** triangles.
4. Cut one 6 7/8" by 6 7/8" Square out of fabric **D** and cut diagonally once. You will have two fabric **D** triangles. This should be your **background fabric**.



Assemble:

1. Follow the diagram and assemble the four patches and then the triangles.
2. Sew the four blocks together to finish your block.
