

# Block of the Month for September

Here is block number seven of our block of the month quilt. This is a very traditional quilt block. There are three shapes this time - triangles, squares, and rectangles. Each letter on the diagram represents a color. Notice that there are two sizes of rectangles cut out of fabric (C). I hope you will join in the fun. As for colors we are still sticking to the **off white background**. You may use any fabric you like for the different squares as long as they are not **too bright** so that they can be sewn together by the winner of this month's blocks. 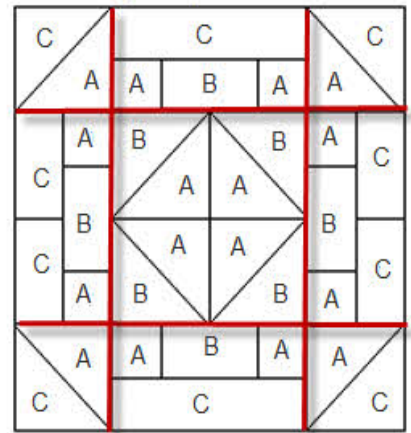
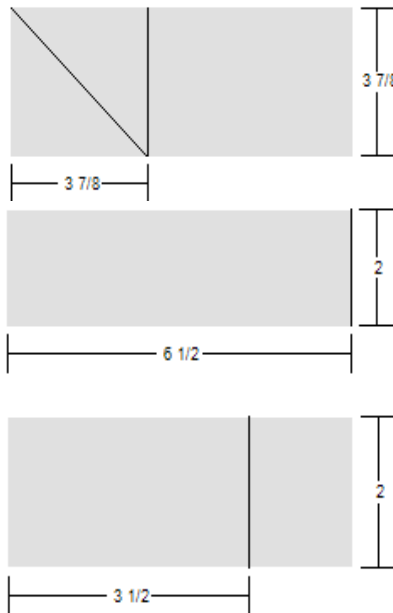

**(Note the colors used in the block above are the ones that I am using for my block of the month Quilt).**

## Cutting:

1. Cut 4 squares  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " from fabric A and then cut diagonally once.
2. Cut 2 squares  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " from both fabric B and C and then cut diagonally once.
3. Cut 2 rectangles  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " by 2" from fabric C.
4. Cut 4 rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " by 2" from both fabrics B and C.
5. Cut 8 squares 2" by 2" from fabric A.



## Assembly

## Assembly:

1. Look at the pieces you have cut out and arrange them in stacks both by color and shape.
2. Follow the assembly diagram to the right. The red (or darker lines) show you how each section and then each row are sewn together.
