

Block Party for January

We will start off the New Year with a fun applique project again. This simple heart block will allow the January winner(s) time to put together a lovely Valentine quilt or table runner. Use iron on or hand applique. The background should be white (solid) or white on white. The heart should be only red and white prints. The block can be simple or see how creative you can be with embellishments. Add some fancy machine stitching around the edge or hand embroidery. You might strip together some red and white prints and cut out your heart. Have some fun with this block. The block is small so turn in more than one!

Materials Needed

Background: 8 1/2" square of plain white or white on white.

Heart: Red and white print.

Instructions

Just center your heart on the 8 1/2" square. The heart measures around 6 1/2" wide by 6" deep.

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
