

Block Party for August

Take an old fashioned simple nine patch, put two opposite pairs together with a bright print against black, mix blocks with a variety of different bright colors, and you have the makings of a spectacular quilt.

Materials Needed

Bright colored print: 2 1/2" x 22.5 " cut into three 7 1/2" pieces.

Plain black fabric: 2 1/2" x 22.5 " cut into three 7 1/2" pieces.

Instructions

Sew together a black, color and black strip set. Press and cut into three 2 1/2" strips. Now sew together a color, black and color strip set and press and cut as above. Sew together as shown into two opposite blocks.

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
