

Block Party for June

There'll be no "June Gloom" here with some bright polka dot fabric. This month we'll be doing a traditional block called Broken Dishes.

Materials needed

Polka dotted fabric: two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Coordinated plain: two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Directions

Start with one of each fabric and make the half-square triangle blocks. Put right sides together of one of each. Draw a diagonal line on the back of one piece and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the drawn line to form two blocks. Repeat for the other two blocks. Sew together as illustrated. Your block will be $8 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. A winning name from those who contributed will be drawn; the winner takes home all the blocks.
