

## Block Party for November

With the holidays approaching we chose this simple traditional block, an easy one to make. The use of solid white and black will give it some pop. You can use any bright color.

### Materials Needed

Background: Solid white, twelve 2 1/2" squares.

Black: four 2 1/2" squares.

Bright print: Four 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles.

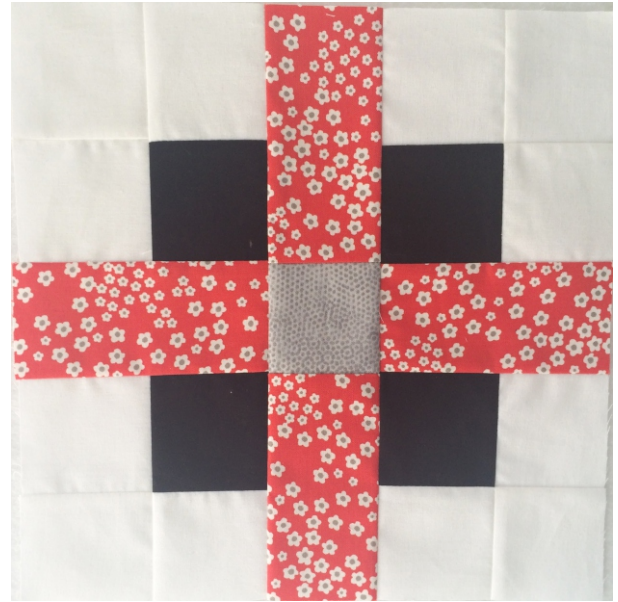
Medium print: One 2 1/2" square. Suggested medium value of the bright color.

### Instructions

Start by making the four corners consisting of three white squares and one black square. Sew two of those with a "bright" rectangle in between and repeat with the other two corners. Now sew "bright" rectangle with "medium" square and "bright rectangle". Now piece together those three rows and you should have a 10 1/2" square.

To participate, make the block described, bring it to the next meeting, post your block(s) on the design board, and place your name (one for each block you bring) into the pot. The winner of the drawing will take home all the blocks.
