

Gentle Curved Piecing and Other Techniques Supply List

What to Bring

Typical quilt-making setup:

- Your sewing machine with its accouterments
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat - largest mat you can bring
- Ripper, pins, thread, rulers
- Design board/wall if possible
- Fabric: Bring choices that play well together. The sizes can range from fat quarters to half yards. Bring a lot to choose from. Bring contrasting fabrics - that is, fabrics that contrast in color or that contrast in value - or both. Bring solids, stripes, dots, pastels, jewel-tones, small print, large print - whatever you like to work with.

Each student should also bring in a fabric that she/he does not like to work with, or find difficult to work with, or what might be simply called: downright ugly.

No matter how much fabric we bring in, we always seem to forget something, not bring enough of something, or didn't understand the assignment. Do not fret about this - I always travel with too much, and I'll have a pile of fabric for you to go through - or just steal from your neighbor!

And final thing to bring: a mind and spirit ready to have fun, ready to forget your rules of block-making, ready to expand, and ready to work!!
