Explore the fun of making the classic Feathered Star faster and more easily using Quick-Strip Paper Piecing for the feathers. Choose from a variety of colorations and settings for completely different looks.



The New Feathered Star
Set on octagon point, 22" block

Supplies:

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Sewing machine, with extension worktable (recommended); size 80 or 90 needles for paper piecing

Open-toed (satin stitch) foot or clear plastic foot, plus regular foot for 1/4" seams

Neutral sewing thread to blend with your fabrics

Fabric scissors and paper scissors, pins, seam ripper and other basic sewing supplies


Paper grocery bag for your trash and trimmings

Iron and ironing board or surface (optional, these can be shared)

Piece of muslin or other light-colored fabric to protect ironing surface from ink of foundation papers

Optional: Template plastic, about 6 1/2" square to fussy cut kite shapes or octagon center if desired

Before class: Spray starch fabrics to be ready for sewing. If you are unsure of your fabric choices, you can bring a variety of fabrics to class and select which ones you would like to use.



Fabrics:

Background: 3/4 yard total if using one fabric, divided as follows:

#2 Feather background triangles: 3/8 yard

#8 Setting triangles and squares: 3/8 yard

Feathers: #1, #3, and #4: 3/8 yard

(If making #3 and #4 different fabric from feather triangles: one 2" strip for #3 and/or #4)

Kite shaped star points #5: 1/4 yard *or* extra fabric if fussy-cutting, enough for 8 repeats

Center triangles #6: 1/8 yard

Center octagon (or square): one 6 1/2" square *or* extra fabric for piecing or fussy-cutting center

Optional: wedge shapes for the New Feathered Star octagon-on-point setting (above, top right): 1/4 yard
